ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

While Bellevue Christian School does not discriminate based on race, color, or national origin, certain criteria must be met to be considered for admission. The following explains our criteria.

Parent Criteria: Bellevue Christian School exists to assist parents in the teaching and training of their children. If this partnership between home and school is to be effective, it is essential that parents meet the following criteria:

1. Parent(s) must be seeking Bellevue Christian School for the training that a Christ-centered curriculum provides, not just the academic benefits of the curriculum.
2. Parent(s) must agree to, and sign, the Statement of Cooperation in the student handbook.
3. Parent(s) agree to fully support all other school policies and procedures.

Student Criteria: Bellevue Christian School exists to help young people grow in Christ-likeness, with a strong emphasis on academic training. It should be recognized that Bellevue may be unable to accept children with certain physical handicaps and learning difficulties beyond the scope of our facilities, program, and staffing. It is essential that the following criteria be met if a student is to grow in our program:

1. Student desires to learn, grow, and has a cooperative attitude to attend Bellevue Christian School.
2. The student must be capable of learning and maturing at the appropriate age and grade level.
3. Kindergarten and preschool children must meet the birth date requirements. (Should be age five by first day of school if enrolling in Kindergarten, age four by first day of school if enrolling for the four-year-old PreKindergarten Class).
