Hassle-Free Mornings – Part 1

If you've ever resorted to nagging, begging, or threatening your kids off to daycare or school, you are not alone! Sadly, when this happens, frequently our relationships suffer and our kids fail to learn important lessons about responsibility and self-sufficiency.

Provided below are some quick tips for placing the lion's share of responsibility on your kids:

1) Remember that even children as young as three or four can learn this skill.

Small children can follow a visual list of tasks they have to complete each morning. Some parents print pictures representing getting dressed, brushing teeth, eating, etc.

2) Practice when you're not stressed. *Wise parents teach their kids how to get ready and practice on a weekend morning.*

3) Rise a bit early and get yourself ready first. *Children learn almost all important skills by watching the "big" people around them. Experiment with saying, "We will help you get ready when we are completely ready ourselves." Help them only when you are completely ready to go. In addition to providing a good example, this allows us to be far more relaxed as we are assisting our kids.*

This year's Bellevue 500 fundraiser is coming soon on **Friday, October 7th!** The funds raised will support the new multi-purpose field and a new child-care playground.

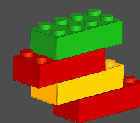
